On October 12, the FLF board approved the following partnership requests by staff for 2018, along with the estimated cost for each:

MACEDONIA PROJECT - UKRAINE

Ukraine Baptist Theological Seminary (UBTS)



The Macedonia Project matches 20 American churches with 20 Ukrainian church planting students. We have several matches in place and would like to match more American churches to the growing number of church planters at UBTS.

In September, FLF will lead a team of individuals to participate in our biennial Church Planter/Pastor retreat in L'viv, Ukraine. The purpose of the retreat is to form new partnerships and deepen existing ones. The cost below will underwrite the costs of the retreat for Ukrainian Church Planters.

Estimated cost: \$1,500

ANTIOCH PROJECT – UKRAINE/POLAND

Ukraine Baptist Theological Seminary (UBTS)

The Antioch Project matches five American churches with five Ukrainian mission students to serve in

THEOLOGICAL EDUCATION OF PASTORS PROJECT – EL SALVADOR

American Baptists of El Salvador (ABES)



In partnership with the ABES Board, FLF will enlist trainers over the next seven years to teach ten pastors, with a goal of having thirty (30) El Salvadorian pastors complete the training and receive a Certificate of Training.

This initiative is fully funded for 2018

ORPHAN CARE INITIATIVE - UKRAINE

Missouri Baptist Children's Home Ukraine Baptist Union New Hope Ukraine

FLF will provide logistical support for leader development between the Missouri Baptist Children's Home, the Baptist Union of Ukraine, and New Hope Ukraine as they address the orphan care crises in Ukraine. The primary financial support for this initiative will be provided by the Missouri Baptist Children's Home as well as some designated gifts.

LEADER DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE - UKRAINE

Ministry Projects for the Year Ahead

STRATEGIC PLANNING PROJECT - BELARUS

Minsk Seminary, Minsk, Belarus

FLF will assist Minsk Seminary in identifying and evaluating seminary strategies, addressing the theological education process and casting a vision for leadership. The event will be held in June 2018 in Riga, Latvia. Field Service Director John Jackson will attend. The estimated cost will underwrite transportation costs, food, and miscellaneous items.

Estimated cost: \$2,000



CAMP AND SEMINAR COORDINATION - LITHUANIA

Southwest Baptist University Global Connections Center Baptist Union of Lithuania Project

For the past two years, FLF has partnered successfully with SBU to provide leadership for a youth camp in Lithuania. Once again, FLF will provide logistical and financial support for SBU students and team leaders coordinating local church camps, The Way Youth Camp and Leadership Seminar in Lithuania. The estimated cost will assist Lithuanian students in participating in the youth camp and provide an opportunity to mentor next generation leaders in the churches.

Estimated cost: \$3,000

PLANNING SUMMIT - MOLDOVA

Moldova Baptist Union

FLF will engage leadership of the Baptist Union of Moldova to investigate "if God willing, for FLF to extend the borders of FLF involvement" in the country of Moldova. (Ion Miron, General Secretary Moldova Baptist Union). Executive Director Greg Morrow will go in February 2018 for these conversations.

This initiative is fully funded for 2018.

PLANNING SUMMIT - POLAND

Poland Baptist Union

FLF will engage the leadership of the Baptist Union of Poland "to both encourage and equip leaders on a national scale" (Mateusz Wichary, President Baptist Union of Poland). Some of the areas of focus



discussed are: pastors' sabbatical program; pastoral care program addressed at a retreat for pastors and spouses; and training youth workers. The estimated costs will help offset the cost for national pastors and spouses to attend and for leadership.

Estimated cost: \$3,000

LEADER DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE -LITHUANIA

Baptist Union of Lithuania

FLF will facilitate a Pastors/Wives Retreat in late May for the purpose of building unity among pastoral leadership in the Union. Field Service Director John Jackson will attend and has enlisted leadership for the retreat. The estimated cost will help offset some of the expenses for the attendees and for the enlisted leader.

Estimated cost: TBD

LEADER DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVE - INDIA

Transforming Leaders in Asia Educational Trust (TLAET)

FLF will recruit skilled persons based upon the identified needs of the TLAET in order to strengthen existing indigenous churches in Asia through Pastor Enrichment Seminars. These will be focused on the devotional life of the pastor, preaching, personal finance and family enrichment.

The event will be March 20-23, 2018, in the Central Eastern region of India. Field Service Director John Jackson will attend. The estimated cost will underwrite conference expenses and assist with trainer travel costs.

Estimated cost: \$2,500

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT – CENTRAL MISSOURI

Global Leadership Summit (GLS)

FLF will provide opportunities to develop young leaders and cultivate



potential FLF partners by purchasing 15 tickets to invite attendees to the GLS at Parkade Baptist Church in Columbia, MO. FLF will also hold a luncheon at GLS for current and new friends of FLF. The estimated cost will cover the 15 tickets and the luncheon.

Estimated cost: \$1,750

IPAD PROJECT

William Jewell College (WJC)



FLF will develop upcoming leaders and support underresourced pastors in the US and around the world by providing refurbished iPads purchased at a discount from WJC. Recipients are asked to invest in the as able while

FLF covers the remaining cost. The estimated cost is for the purchase of 15 iPads.

Estimated cost: \$1,925

CHURCH PLANTING PARTNERSHIP - UKRAINE

Southwest Baptist University Inter-Cultural Studies Department Kiev Church Plant Project

FLF will provide logistical support in placing SBU students for six months with the Kiev Church Plant



Project. "The idea of Intercultural Studies students to come to Kiev for six months is just great!" (Andre Khudyakov; church planter). The students from SBU will arrive in late January and will serve through the end of June. The estimated cost is two scholarships for the students from

SBU to help with their expenses.

Estimated cost: \$1,000
