Today we ask you to pray for safety as they travel tomorrow, to be with the airlines, pilots and flight crews as well.</p>
<b>Friday,</b> <b>June 2</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">Isaiah 25:1</a>          Ask for God's guidance as the conference leaders finalize all of the plans for June 12-19.</p>	<b>Monday,</b> <b>June 12</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">Psalm 121:7-8</a>          Continue to remember those flying to the conference from Houston, St. Louis and Springfield, for on-time flights, baggage and supplies.</p>

<b>Monday,</b> <b>June 5</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">1 John 5:14-15</a>          Today, remember the conference's break-out session leaders as they prepare, that they are able to share needed concepts and resources.</p>	<b>Thursday,</b> <b>June 15</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">Philippians 1:3-5</a>          Pray for joy in the reunions and fellowship as our national leaders arrive from around the world</p>
<b>Tuesday,</b> <b>June 6</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">Ephesians 6:18</a>          Today we ask for the plenary session leaders as they prepare to teach and worship.</p>	<b>Friday,</b> <b>June 16</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">1 Corinthians 9:22</a>          Pray for friendships and networks to be created and strengthened as the conference starts today, and God's continual guidance in planning future ministry with our international partners as well.</p>
<b>Wednesday,</b> <b>June 7</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">2 Peter 1:20</a>          Pray for supernatural communication across language barriers so that we are able to listen to one another even as we worship in many tongues.</p>	<b>Saturday,</b> <b>June 17</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">1 Corinthians 10:16-17</a>          Give thanks and praise as we celebrate communion internationally and remember Christ's sacrifice for us.</p>
<b>Thursday,</b> <b>June 8</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">Psalm 22:22-27</a>          Give thanks to God for allowing this meeting to take place, for each participant and for the opportunity to glorify God through our worship and sharing.</p>	<b>Sunday,</b> <b>June 18</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">1 Chronicles 29:11-13</a>          Today, our group will worship in local churches. Pray that God is glorified in worship and that Gods Spirit is felt powerfully in each setting.</p>
<b>Friday,</b> <b>June 9</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">Matthew 6:34</a>          Remember the technical needs during this upcoming conference, for equipment to work and materials to be available.</p>	<b>Monday,</b> <b>June 19</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">Psalm 139:9-10</a>          As the group returns home, pray again for safety as we return to serve God in our local settings.</p>
<b>Saturday,</b> <b>June 10</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">1 Corinthians 2:9-10</a>          Pray that each person be filled with hope, excitement and anticipation for inspiring worship, preaching, teaching and fellowship.</p>	<b>Tuesday,</b> <b>June 20</b>	<p>Today's Scripture: <a href="#">1 Corinthians 3:6-8</a>          Pray for continued momentum from this time together, that the seeds that have been planted take root and flourish to the glory of God.</p>
